COURSE OF FIRE:

Skeet: 250 (75+50+Finals+75+50+Finals) Double Trap: 300 (150+Finals+150+Finals) Trap: 250 (75+50+Finals+75+50+Finals)

ELIGIBILITY:

This is an open match. All competitors must be current members of USA Shooting in order to participate. The match will be open to international guests as well. International athletes must be a member of their home federation. All international athletes should submit a copy of the picture page of their passport with their entry form. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible for the finals.

TEAM SELECTION:

This match will serve as the first Olympic selection match for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janerio, Brazil. For detailed Olympic selection procedures click <u>here</u>.

SQUADDING:

Squads for OTR days will be at random. Squads for day 1 will be at random and held for day 2. For day 3, men and women will be separated and squadded high-to-low and held for day 4.

PERFORMANCE STANDARDS:

This match will count towards Performance Standard Average (PSA) and Individual Performance Scores (PSI). Performance Standard Average / Individual Performance Scores, as established by USA Shooting, must be achieved before any athlete may travel with the US Shooting Team to selected competitions outside the United States. USAS has suspended the PSA/PSI standards for 2015 due to the significant changes in ISSF and USAS Rules. Scores at this competition may be used in future Performance Standard calculations. USAS will publish the new PSA/PSI standards in October.

RULES:

Current 2015 USA Shooting Rules will govern this competition. It is the shooters responsibility to be familiar with these rules. Match Directors Bulletins will also govern this match. Jeans and camouflage will not be permitted.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers in the Open categories on the final day of the event. No junior awards will be presented. High scoring awards will be presented to the top Visitor, Senior and Collegiate, provided there are at least three competitors in each category. Class awards will not be awarded at this event.

JURY:

A Competition Jury will be appointed. A decision by the Competition Jury is final.

Equipment check will be performed on the fields. Skeet markers will be available for sale.

FINALS

Finals will be conducted for the top six Open competitors in each event. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible for the Finals. Juniors are eligible for finals; however there will be no junior finals. Any ties after the final will be broken in accordance with the written Selection Procedures.

BASIC INFORMATION

- 1. The United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) may conduct testing for banned substances.
 - a. Competitors or their physicians may address questions concerning medication to the USADA Drug Hotline at 1-800-233-0393.
 - b. Remember that even over-the-counter medications can contain a banned substance. Always check first with your doctor and the Drug Hotline before taking any medication.

SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Please keep in mind that the match schedule and squadding are subject to change. Although we make every attempt to maintain the published schedule, target malfunctions, weather and other items are out of our control. It is the responsibility of competitors and/or coaches to check the schedule and squadding daily and most importantly in the evening. It is also important to maintain a valid email address within our Rail Station system, as we will send notifications via email (if needed). USAS is not responsible for missed flights, airline change fees, missed relays, etc. Please keep this in mind when making your travel arrangements and schedules.
