There will be Open Training for Skeet/Double Trap which will be determined as we near the start of the event. Typically, this training occurs after Trap is complete for the day and is limited.

ELIGIBILITY:

This is an open match. All competitors must be current members of USA Shooting in order to participate. The match will be open to international guests as well. International athletes must be a member of their home federation. All international athletes should submit a copy of the picture page of their passport with their entry. To enter as an international guest, please email jack@hillcountryshootingsports.com. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible for the finals.

SQUADDING:

Squadding for this match will be done at the Match Directors discretion.

TEAM SELECTION:

RULES:

Current 2016 USA Shooting Rules will govern this competition. It is the shooters responsibility to be familiar with these rules. See the Selection and Finals Procedures located on the USAS website.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers in the Open categories on the final day of the event. High scoring awards will be presented to the top Junior, Visitor, Senior and Collegiate, provided there are at least three competitors in each category. Class awards will not be awarded at this event.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers in the Open Men's & Women's categories on the final day of each vent. Class awards **will not** be awarded at this event.

USADA:

The United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) may conduct testing for banned substances.

- a. Competitors or their physicians may address questions concerning medication to the USADA Drug Hotline at 1-800-233-0393.
- b. Remember that even over-the-counter medications can contain a banned substance. Always check first with your doctor and the Drug Hotline before taking any medication.

JURY:

A Competition Jury will be appointed. A decision by the Competition Jury is final.

FIREARMS & AMMUNITION STORAGE:

There will be no overnight firearms or ammunition storage at the range.

AMMUNITION:

Ammo will be available for purchase – Winchester AA - \$85.00/flat

TRAINING ROUNDS:

Unofficial training rounds will be available at the HCSSC. Open training will be available each non-competition day from 19 September till the end of the day of OTR for each event. This will be on a first come – first served basis. The range closes at 7pm each day. Cost of open training rounds will be \$5.50 each for Skeet, \$6.75 each for Trap and \$8.25 each for DT.

EQUIPMENT CHECK:

Procedures for equipment checks will be announced before the match starts.

FINALS:

Finals will be conducted for the top six Open competitors in each event. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible for the Finals. Any ties after the final will be broken in accordance with USAS Rules. There will be no Junior finals.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

By registering for this competition you are agreeing to abide by the USA Shooting Code of Conduct both on and off the range complex for the duration of the event. As a participant, you are representing our sport and organization. Providing an example of good conduct, appearance and sportsmanship is paramount. The Code of Conduct is available in the Competition Entry Office and on the USAS website. You must also agree to abide by any and all range specific rules, to include eye and ear protection.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:
