

USA SHOOTING TEAM SELECTION PROCEDURES

OTHER ISSF-TYPE COMPETITIONS

Teams for ISSF World Cups and other ISSF type matches other than those specifically mentioned in Section III Appendices A, B, C, D & E will be selected according to the following procedures:

1. Only National Team (NT) and National Development Team (NDT) athletes will be selected for funded participation by the National Coaches. Selection will be based on country quota requirements, budget impact, need for individual MQS, demonstrated progress and development needs of team members. One or more of the criteria cited may be used in the selection procedure.
2. In addition to criteria listed above, performance standard requirements according to Policies and Procedures, Section VI, will be used as a guide in selecting participants. Exceptions may be made by the National Coach with the approval of the Director of Operations.
3. Any non-NT/NDT member or Junior Olympic Team member selected to participate will do so at no expense to USA Shooting. Such participants must sign and abide by the Code of Conduct and Participant Agreement. Selection of non-NT/NDT or Junior Olympic Team members must be approved by the Director of Operations.
4. For the year following the Olympic Games, the rifle and pistol athletes selected to compete at one ISSF World Cup will be selected in the following manner:
 - a. Qualifying rifle and pistol athletes from the USA Shooting CAT selection procedure will be funded to compete in one ISSF World Cup. The World Cup will be determined by the National Coaches and approved by the Director of Operations based on athlete availability and USA Shooting performance needs or requirements. The selection procedure is outlined in Section III.
 - b. Athletes selected to this World Cup team will be automatically named to the National Team.
 - c. Performance standard requirements will be waived for athletes selected for this World Cup only.
 - d. Athletes meeting the selection criteria for more than one team (CAT and this World Cup) must select one match in which to compete. This decision will be given to the National Coach upon completion of the selection match.

e. This World Cup team will be selected in the order listed below:
