

2021 WINTER AIRGUN FINALS & TEAM EVENTS FORMATS

Pistol 3-Person Team

- December 7, 2021
- People will shoot a normal 60-shot relay
- Each teammate's 60-shot relay will be added, totaling 180 shots for the team
- Teams will be qualified for Round 2 based on the 180-shot team total
 - Most teams will be able to shoot in Round 2, because we can fit 25 teams at a time
- Round 2 will have each teammate shoot 20 shots in 20 minutes following a 5-minute sighting period, totaling 60 shots for the team
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place teams will all have the same report time following Round 2.
- 3rd and 4th place team after Round 2 shoot in the Bronze medal match immediately following
 - 8 minutes before start time, athletes get called to the line
 - 3 minutes of sighters and prep before start time
 - After match starts, each teammate fires 1 shot in 50 seconds and the combined team score is compared to the other team's combined score
 - The team with the highest combined score in each round, compared against the other team in the Match, wins two (2) points.
 - In case of equal scores each team receives one (1) point.
 - The first team to reach sixteen (16) points or more will win the Match.
 - In case of a tie where both teams have scored at least sixteen (16) points, the Match will continue with one (1) additional shot fired by both members of each team to decide the tie.
 - If the scores are still tied the teams will continue to shoot additional shots on command until the tie is broken.
- 1st and 2nd place team after Round 2 shoot in the Gold medal match immediately following
 - 8 minutes before start time, athletes get called to the line
 - 3 minutes of sighters and prep before start time

Pistol 2-Person Team

- December 8, 2021
- We will run it similar to ISSF format
 - Teams do not have to be 1 man and 1 woman, though. That way everyone will get a chance to compete
- Teammates will stand side-by-side and shoot 30 shots in 30 minutes following a 10-minute sighting period, totaling 60 shots for the team
- Teams will be qualified for Round 2 based on their 60-shot score
 - We will fit as many teams as we can into Round 2 based on range capacity
- Round 2 has teammates standing side-by-side to shoot 20 shots in 20 minutes following a 5-minute sighting period, totaling 40 shots for the team
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place teams will all have the same report time following Round 2.
- 3rd and 4th place team after Round 2 shoot in the Bronze medal match immediately following
 - 8 minutes before start time, athletes get called to the line
 - 3 minutes of sighters and prep before start time
 - After match starts, each teammate fires 1 shot in 50 seconds and the combined team score is compared to the other team's combined score
 - The team with the highest combined score in each round, compared against the other team in the Match, wins two (2) points.
