

## 2021 WINTER AIRGUN FINALS & TEAM EVENTS FORMATS

### Rifle Super Finals

- December 9 – U15 Super Final, U18 Super Final
- December 10 – U21 Super Final, Para Super Final (Anniston only – SH1 & SH2)
- December 11 – Over 21 Super Final
- You are entered into the Super Final based on your match day score from **that day**
- Most likely, there will be too many U18 competitors to fit them all into the Super Final. If that's the case, then the top qualifiers from that match day will fill the Super Final until range capacity is met (likely 75)
- All competitors will shoot the final with 2 series of 5 shots, totaling 10 shots
- Then, all competitors will be eliminated from the final except for the top 8
- Then, the final continues on as a normal ISSF final would, until the first place finisher is left
  - Two shots in between each elimination
  - Totaling 24 shots for the final
- Right after the silver medal and gold medal winners are determined, all three medal winners get handed their prizes very quickly and casually
  - Each medalist gets one small gold medal.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place will get a \$50 gift card to our online store
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place will get a \$35 gift card to our online store
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place will get a \$25 gift card to our online store
- Then, quickly get off the line so the next Super Final can start
- There are no official report times for these finals
  - After each qualification relay, we should announce reminders that the Super Finals for each day's category will take place right after the final relay of the day

### Rifle 3-Person Teams

- December 12, 2021 – right after ISSF Finals
- Round 1 for the 3-Person team qualification will be the aggregate score from Match Day 1 and Match Day 2 of each team member (120 shots per person, 360 shots per team).
- This will be calculated Friday, December 10 after all relays that day have completed
- An email should go out that night (Friday, December 10) notifying which teams have qualified for Round 2
  - We will fit as many teams as we can into the range. On one side of the range will be "Open" teams meaning they have at least 1 over 21 competitor. On the other side of the range will be purely Junior teams.
  - Teams can be mix of men, women, juniors, open, and para
    - Only 1 Paralympic person can be on each team
- In Round 2, teammates will shoot side-by-side for 20 shots in 20-minutes after a 10-minute sighting period, totally 60 shots for the team.
- Each team's 60 shot score will determine if they proceed to the next round.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place team after Round 2 shoot in the Bronze medal match immediately following
  - 8 minutes before start time, athletes get called to the line

- 3 minutes of sighters and prep before start time
- After match starts, each teammate fires 1 shot in 50 seconds and the combined team score is compared to the other team's combined score
- The team with the highest combined score in each round, compared against the other team in the Match, wins two (2) points.
- In case of equal scores each team receives one (1) point.
- The first team to reach sixteen (16) points or more will win the Match.
- In case of a tie where both teams have scored at least sixteen (16) points, the Match will continue with one (1) additional shot fired by both members of each team to decide the tie.
- If the scores are still tied the teams will continue to shoot additional shots on command until the tie is broken.
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place team after Round 2 shoot in the Gold medal match immediately following
  - 8 minutes before start time, athletes get called to the line
  - 3 minutes of sighters and prep before start time
  - After match starts, each teammate fires 1 shot in 50 seconds and the combined team score is compared to the other team's combined score
  - The team with the highest combined score in each round, compared against the other team in the Match, wins two (2) points.
  - In case of equal scores each team receives one (1) point.
  - The first team to reach sixteen (16) points or more will win the Match.
  - In case of a tie where both teams have scored at least sixteen (16) points, the Match will continue with one (1) additional shot fired by both members of each team to decide the tie.
  - If the scores are still tied the teams will continue to shoot additional shots on command until the tie is broken.
- Awards for all categories and the 3-Person team match will be done immediately following
