2020 ISSF Event Selection Procedures

- Expenses for funded slots will be covered by USA Shooting.
- Expenses for self-funded slots will be covered by the athlete and will also include a percentage of the expenses incurred from coach, psychology, and physio support. Self-funded slots may become funded slots if budgets permit.

New Dehli World Cup (Mar 15-26, 2020)

Smallbore selection will be based on the results from the Smallbore Olympic Trials I.

- Smallbore in-competition slots will be self-funded and will be offered, in order until filled, to athletes ranked from 1st through 8th place.

- Smallbore MQS slots will be self-funded and will be offered, in order until filled, to athletes ranked from 4th - 8th place.

Air Rifle selection will be based on the results from the full Air Rifle Olympic Trials (Air Rifle Olympic Trials I + Air Rifle Olympic Trials II).

- Two funded Air Rifle in-competition slots will be offered to the two Air Rifle Olympic Team members. Remaining in-competition slots will be self-funded and offered, in order until filled, to athletes ranked from 3rd - 8th place.
- Air Rifle MQS slots will be self-funded and offered, in order until filled, to athletes ranked from 4th - 8th place.
- The Air Rifle Mixed Team event will be selected from the top two ranked men and the top two ranked women from the full Air Rifle Olympic Trials results who are participating in-competition in the Air Rifle event at the New Delhi World Cup.

Tokyo Test Event (Apr 15-27, 2020)

Selection will be based on the results from the full Olympic Trials (Olympic Trials I + Olympic Trials II).

- Slots will be offered to Olympic Team members.

Lima Pan American Championships (May 8-17, 2020)

Munich World Cup (Jun 2-9, 2020)

Baku World Cup (Jun 22-Jul 3, 2020)

Selection for the Lima Pan American Championships (if the Organizing Committee restricts participation to make this a protected event), the Munich World Cup, and the Baku World Cup will be based on the results from the full Olympic Trials (Olympic Trials I + Olympic Trials II), and from the Junior World Championship Trials.

- Two funded in-competition slots will be offered to the two Olympic Team members. Remaining slots will be self-funded and offered, in order until filled, to athletes ranked from 3rd - 8th place from the full Olympic Trials results. If any in-competition slots still remain, they will be passed down to the Junior World Championship Team in order of their ranking from the Junior World Championship Trials in that event.
- Available MQS slots will be offered to the members of the Junior World Championship Team not already in-competition, in order of their ranking from the Junior World Championship Trials in that event.
- Selection for the Air Rifle Mixed Team event will be from the top two ranked men and the top two ranked women from the full Air Rifle Olympic Trials results who are participating in-competition in the Air Rifle event at the Championship or World Cup.

Junior World Championships, Suhl, GER (Jul 11-19, 2020)

Selection will be based on the results from the Junior World Championship Trials.

- Slots will be offered to athletes ranked from 1st - 3rd in the Smallbore 3x40 and in the Air Rifle events. Slots not filled will be passed down in order of the ranking in that event until filled.
- The ranking from the total Smallbore 3x40 results will be used as the selection for the Prone events at the Junior World Championships. Athletes must participate in-competition in the Smallbore 3x40 event at the Junior World Championships in order to compete in the Prone event.
- The Air Rifle Mixed Team event will be selected from the top two ranked men and the top two ranked women from the Junior World Championship Trials Air Rifle results. Athletes must participate in-competition in the Air Rifle event at the Junior World Championships in order to compete in the Air Rifle Mixed Team event.
